Routine monitoring of your water quality and systems can lead to significant improvements in effective operations. This course covers daily and weekly practices that any operator can perform for better control of their water/wastewater system. The Activated Sludge Process has limitations in handling toxic influents of unknown origin and strength. Once the bug population is destroyed or inactivated due to toxicity, or loading issues, regrowth is a painful time consuming process.
