Joel Jordan

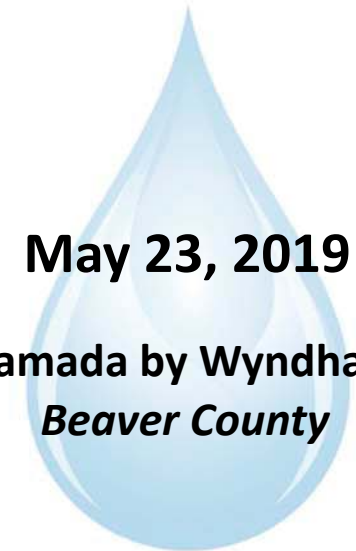
Director of Education
