6.5 WATER AND WASTEWATER CONTACT HOURS

- Prepare samples for Total Nitrogen and Total Phosphorous pH

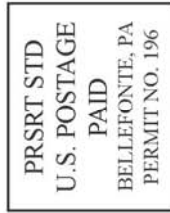

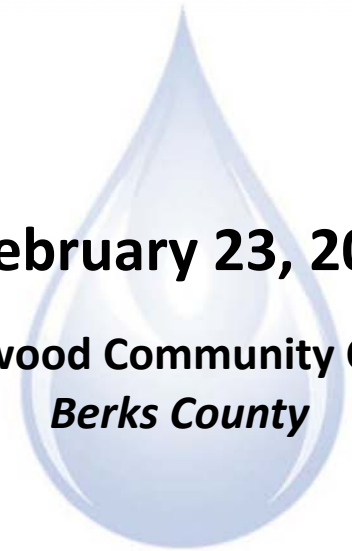
